With the Christmas Season just ahead of us, it's time to remind everyone of the policies pertaining to grave decorations. Wreaths are the preferred decoration; they should be tied to the monument. If you wish to use a grave spray, be sure that it is placed against the monument and tied to it. **Do not use grave blankets** that span the entire length of the grave. **Above all, do not use metal stakes to fasten decorations to the ground.** Vigil lights should be removed for the winter months. Breakage can result from the freeze-thaw action. The cemetery is not responsible for vigil lights for any reason.
